EXPLANATION OF RESOLUTIONS FOR THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS MEETING OF DECEMBER 15, 2025

1. <u>Resolution 12-01-2025</u> - Resolution authorizing the transaction, approving the list of bills for November 2025, authorizing an expenditure of funds, subject to appropriations, ratification of expenditures

These bills are expenses that the LBHA has incurred for payment for the month of November 2025, i.e., utilities, repairs, supplies, payroll, services performed, etc.

2. <u>Resolution 12-02-2025</u> – Resolution approving the transaction, authorizing the Long Branch Housing Authority Housing Choice Voucher Program Small Area Fair Market Rents (SAFMRS) for 2026

Small Area Fair Market Rents (SAFMRs) are designed to set payment standards for Housing Choice Voucher (HCV) programs based on ZIP codelevel rent data rather than metropolitan-wide averages.

3. <u>Resolution 12-03-2025</u> - Resolution approving the transaction, authorizing appointment of a Fund Commissioner for the Long Branch Housing Authority to the Joint Insurance Fund (JIF)

The bylaws of JIF Fund require that each Housing Authority member appoint a Fund Commissioner to represent and serve the Authority as its' representative to said Fund.

4. <u>Resolution 12-04-2025</u> – Resolution approving the transaction, authorizing a lease with the City of Long Branch for the Adam "Bucky" James Community Center, subject to the approval of HUD, ratification of past action

LBHA will enter into a lease with the City of Long Branch for the Department of Recreation and Human Services to use space at the Adam "Bucky" James Community Center.

5. <u>Resolution 12-05-2025</u> – Resolution approving the transaction, authorizing a write-off of Tenant Account Receivables (TARs) for Fiscal Year ending June 30, 2025

To authorize the write-off of uncollectible Tenant Account Receivables (TARs) for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2025, ensuring that the Housing Authority's financial statements accurately reflect collectible tenant balances

- and comply with HUD's Public Housing Assessment System (PHAS) and Generally Accepted Accounting Principles (GAAP).
- 6. <u>Resolution 12-06-2025</u> Resolution authorizing the transaction, adopting amendments to the Long Branch Housing Authority (LBHA) *Procurement Policy*
 - Adoption of the amended Procurement Policy of the LBHA, in accordance with all applicable local, state, and federal laws and regulations.
- 7. <u>Resolution 12-07-2025</u> Resolution authorizing the transaction, approving the amendment to the Housing Authority of the City of Long Branch (LBHA) *Internal Control Policy*

- 10. <u>Resolution 12-10-2025</u> Resolution authorizing the transaction, authorizing a contract for On Call Snow Removal Services at Garfield Court and John R. A contract has been awarded to Scenic View Landscaping to provide on-call snow removal services at Garfield Court and John R. Lewis Commons for the period of December 1, 2025, through June 30, 2026.
